



Treasurer's Report Fiscal Year 2014 - 2015

Thank you to all the organizations, towns, and people that choose to support our Mission by contributing to the Thompson. This year our Meals on Wheels program received well-deserved attention and support. Our Annual Valentine's Dinner and Auction was very successful, introducing new trip items that had significant interest. Grants increased from 2014. Total expenses were under control versus budget despite major repair expenses for the sprinkler system, kitchen, and van. Capital expenditures were for the new walk-in refrigerator/freezer and fundraising software. The Board and staff continue to be committed to control expenses and sustaining fundraising revenue, but we are unable to break even and must continue to depend on our invested funds.
